Volunteers are very important to our Sanctuary and we welcome all of the help we can get. There are some important points to consider and some ground rules that must be followed. Our sanctuary is first and foremost the animals' home and so each volunteer must be prepared to work around the animals. None of our animals are aggressive but they are large and do not always watch where they are going. Appropriate attire is required which includes long pants, closed toe shoes and socks. The barnyard is truly a barnyard and there are inherent risks involved in working around the animals. Closed toe shoes protect our volunteers' feet from being trod upon and long pants provide protection from mosquitoes and other insects such as fire ants. Certain areas are absolutely off limits without the Director's personal permission and supervision - these include the horse stalls and paddocks and the areas that house the bison and cattle. We hope that you will gain valuable experience and have fun while assisting us at the Sanctuary. At the same time, it is important to understand that adherence to the rules will protect both you and the animals.
